If you're eager to connect with some of the world's fresh new engineering minds, one of the best ways to get to know our students is through participation in the **Illinois Engineering Career Services (ECS) Job Shadow Program**. This program offers undergraduate students the opportunity to preview your company by spending one work day on site, and because the Job Shadow Program is held over the University of Illinois Winter Break, there are no conflicts with classes.

Employers select the day, determine the agenda for the visit, and the number of students to host. We ask employers to be open to all Engineering majors, as we have a number of students who are still exploring career possibilities as Undeclared Engineering Majors. ECS staff market job shadow opportunities to students based on the information employers provide in advance. Students are responsible for all travel and lodging expenses as well as transportation.

We hope you'll participate in this important Job Shadow Program. Our students are eager to experience "a day in the life of an engineer" at your company.

Oct. 31, 2016	Last day for employers to post Job Shadow opportunities and information on I-Link (Engineering)
Nov. 19	Employers receive PDF of all resumes submitted by student applicants
Dec. 9	Deadline for employers to contact selected students to invite them for a Job Shadow and arrange details of the visit
Jan. 9 – 13, 2017	Job shadow visits occur
Jan. 17	Employer feedback requested to ECS
